ADULT RESCUE MANAGEMENT PROTOCOL

These include fever, chills, rigors, headache, rash, itching, swelling, edema, nausea, vomiting, abdominal pain, hypotension, and respiratory distress.

- Following standing reaction orders, including diphenhydramine, methylprednisolone, albuterol, and oxygen as needed.
- For severe reactions, administer Epi-pen or equivalent and call 911. Repeat if severe symptoms persist.
